

WILDERNESS LAKES TRAILS - DEVELOPMENT PLAN

- Phase 1 - Completed in 2004**
A The Land O' Lakes trail is an existing 8 mile black-top surface.
- Phase 2 - Completion in 2009**
B Eagle River Connector Route: This will be a shared-use route utilizing county and town roads connecting the existing Land O' Lakes Trail and the Three Eagle Trail in Eagle River.
- C** The Border Lakes Trail will consist of a shared-use bike route utilizing a paved Michigan county road (Thousand Island Lake Road).
- D** The Watersmeet Trail will consist of a shared-use bike route utilizing paved Michigan County (Old U.S. 2) and Township roads.
- Phase 3 - Completion in 2010**
E Western Extension of the existing Land O' Lakes Trail This will consist of a newly constructed trail of approximately 2 miles in length on private property and a 0.6 mile shared-use section on a paved town road (Forest Lake Road).
- F** The Wisconsin section of the Border Lakes Trail will consist of a shared-use of a newly paved Land O' Lakes town road (Thousand Island Lake Road).
- G** The LVD Casino spur which will connect Bass Lake and the casino with the Watersmeet Trail.
- Phase 4 - Completion in 2011**
H The central section of the Agonikak Trail which will consist of a newly surfaced existing trail connecting Military Road with Allen Lake Road.
- Phase 5 - Completion in 2012**
J A section of the Border Lakes Trail which will consist of a newly surfaced existing trail connecting the Wisconsin trail to Helen Lake utilizing U.S. Forest Service property. This will replace the shared-use bike route for this part of the trail.
- K** The northern section of the Agonikak Trail which will consist of a newly surfaced existing trail connecting Watersmeet with Allen Lake Road.
- L** The northern section of the Border Lakes Trail will consist of a combination of newly surfaced trail on U.S. Forest Service and State of Michigan property and shared-use township roads.
- Phase 6 - Completion in 2013**
M The final section of the Border Lakes trail to replace the shared-use county road (Thousand Island Lake Road).
- N** The southern section of the Agonikak Trail which will consist of a newly surfaced existing trail connecting Military and Land O' Lakes. It will also consist of a 1/4 mile shared-use town road (Crystal Lake Road).
